

DCP001 – Request for Information Note

1. Overview

DCP001 is a draft Change Proposal raised by MOSL which seeks to add Tariff Standing Data to the Tariffs Report and change the report's logic to display only applicable Charging Elements. The draft Change Proposal also proposes the introduction of certain clarificatory elements which improve the readability of the CSDs which deal with Tariffs or the Tariffs Report.

The proposed changes will improve the visibility of charging arrangements for both Retailers and Wholesalers and will ensure that the content of the Tariffs Report more closely matches the structure of the tariffs as loaded in CMOS.

1.1 Central System Implementation Costs

CGI has confirmed that DCP001 will have a CMOS implementation cost of £12,523.
