

Carbon statement information

To coincide with COP26, we have developed a **carbon statement** for each trading party that is available in your individual trading party SharePoint area.

These carbon statements aim to draw attention to GHG emissions from water and sewerage treatment in the non-household market, and start a discussion on the data currently available and required to support the water sector's commitment to [achieving net zero by 2030](#).

The carbon statements use Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emission data provided to Ofwat annually by water companies in England and Wales. These are published on the [Discover Water](#) website. We have linked these GHG rates to volumes available on the volumetric service components in CMOS based on the latest R1 settlement run available (excluding Trade Effluent).

These individual trading party carbon statements have been created based on R1 settlement data.

For wholesalers, your carbon statement shows GHG emissions by service component for each retailer operating in your region.

For retailers, your carbon statement shows GHG emissions by service component for each wholesaler region you operate in.

The carbon statements present summary information on the proportion of non-household carbon emissions by trading party, and the proportion of service component charges that are volume based and therefore been matched to a carbon estimate. Detailed breakdowns by service component show actual and estimated volumes, charges and GHG estimates where volume is available.
