## Change Proposal/ Charging Change Proposal Details

Description of (i) the issue or defect which this Change Proposal seeks to address

This seeks to address the mixing of Production and Test transactions, which is detrimental to both business and testing personnel, by means of a drop-down environment selector

Description of the Change Proposal its nature and purpose and (for Change Proposals only) how it is consistent with the Principles and falls within the Objectives noted below,

As part of the recently introduced Market Operator Portal, a Peek and Dequeue facility has been provided which Trading Parties can opt to use via configuration changes, prompted by the submission of a proforma.

The new facility addresses some of the shortcomings of the standard CMOS Low Volume Interface Notifications facility, although some potential further improvements may be identified in a separate NCC document, but all .M transactions are directed to it regardless of whether they relate to the Production or MPS2 environments.

A means of separating the transactions by environment is required, and the suggestion is that this is delivered via a drop-down selector defaulted to Production, as the great majority of transactions will relate to that environment.

The provision of a selector will mean that business staff only see and download Production transactions, whilst testing staff will be able to see and download MPS2 transactions.
