This involves assessing trading parties' proposed plans, progress, existing processes, and any risks they have identified during this journey.

As a part of this investigate work, MOSL is developing a series of 'use cases' that outline how granular consumption data can and will be used to generate benefit for the market and its customers. The output from this work will be used alongside the insight gained from this RFI to support the development of an effective data sharing mechanism.
